This Latin grace at meals is traditionally sung at gatherings of Carmelites on special occasions.

- V. Tu autem, Domine, miserere nostri.
And Thou, O Lord, have mercy on us.
- R. Deo Gratias.
Thanks be to God.
- V. Laudate Dominum, omnes gentes.
Oh praise the Lord, all ye nations.
- R. Laudate eum, omnes populi.
Glorify Him, all ye people.
- V. Quoniam confirmata est super nos misericordia ejus.
For his mercy is confirmed upon us.
- R. Et veritas Domini manet in aeternum.
And the faithfulness of the Lord remains forever.
- V. Gloria Patri , et Filio, et Spiritui Sancto.
Glory be to the Father, and to the Son, and to the Holy Spirit.
- R. Sicut erat in principio, et nunc, et semper, et in saecula saeculorum. Amen.
As it was in the beginning, is now, and ever shall be, world without end. Amen.
- V. Sit nomen Domini benedictum.
Blessed be the name of the Lord.
- R. Ex hoc nunc et usque in saeculum.
Both now and forever.
